ORDER

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Petition for Writ of Election and the reasons stated therein, and pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 24.2-226 and 24.2-682, the Court finds that a special election is hereby ordered and the Electoral Board serving the Town of Louisa is directed to take steps and prepare such means as may be necessary to hold the special election to fill the office of Mayor on the first Tuesday in November, 2025, which is the date of the 2025 general election. This Court further ORDERS the Electoral Board and General Registrar to observe the directives set forth in § 24.2-681 *et seq.* of the Code of Virginia when conducting this Special Election. This Court further ORDERS that the Secretary of the Electoral Board shall coordinate with the Town to post a copy of this Writ on the official website for the Town and have notice of the election published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this jurisdiction at least ten (10) days before the special election.

NOTHING FURTHER remaining to be done herein, this matter is removed from the active docket of this Court and placed among the ended cases. The Clerk is directed to send an attested copy of this Order to the State Board of Elections, as required by § 24.2-683 of the Code of Virginia, and to counsel of record.


