



Lifting Boil Water Advisory

Boil Water Advisory to Consumers of The Town of Louisa LIFTED

As of February 20, 2026 the Boil Water Advisory has been lifted for 420 W. Main St. in Louisa County.

The Boil Water Advisory was issued on February 16, 2026 due to a water main break which caused system pressure loss.

A series of bacteriological samples were collected and sent to a state certified lab. All samples collected on February 18, 2026 and February 19, 2026 were absent of both total coliform and *E. coli* bacteria in the area where the Boil Water Advisory is currently being lifted.

Following flushing the service line and premise plumbing, residents can safely resume normal use of their tap water.
